Perched on the edge of the 40-meter-high Aurora cliff, overhanging the sea, is a miniature snow-white building called the swallow's nest. This monument of architecture and history, immortalized on the coat of arms of the village of Gaspra, is considered a symbol of the southern coast of Crimea.

The swallow's nest, built in a pseudo-Gothic style, resembles a knight's castle. Battlements with pointed windows rise in ledges to a round three-tiered tower with spires crowning the entire structure. The interior of the "swallow's nest" can not be called luxurious, there are no decorations, except for ancient fireplaces and beams made of black wood with supports in the form of frogs. The size of the castle is not great: width — 10 meters, length — 20 meters and height — 12 meters, but it impresses with its good location — between the sea and the sky.
